Limited Lifetime Warranty

Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc. warrants the original homeowner purchaser, for as long as they own their home, that cabinetry, countertops, materials and labor we provide will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal household use and service at the original site of installation. This warranty is only applicable to our products used in residential applications within the State of Georgia and is not transferable to subsequent owners. This warranty is only applicable if the cabinetry is contracted with and purchased directly from Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc.

Should defects in material or installation workmanship exist, Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc., at its sole discretion and following thorough reviews and inspection of the product, will either repair or replace the defective product or fix the installation. In all cases of cabinetry defects, this warranty will apply to and applicable for only to the limits and duration of the particular cabinet manufacturers', countertop suppliers' or outside suppliers' warranty. Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc. warranty for cabinet defects will be limited by the obligations and promises made to the retail client under the cabinet manufacturers' written warranty in effect at the time of purchase. Countertop warranties are limited to the warranty provided by the countertop manufacturer, distributor, fabricator, and installer. Not covered are parts and materials of the products originally supplied by the cabinet manufacturer or countertop supplier. This warranty does cover all labor and other costs to remove and reinstall cabinets, parts, materials and related components. Schuon Kitchens' warranty will be considered to be null and void if Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc. is no longer an authorized dealer or distributor of the particular line of cabinetry sold to a retail client.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by others or beyond the control of Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc. including but not limited to damage caused by misuse, abuse, accident, neglect, alteration, mishandling, improper installation, improper storage, failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance, or by flood, fire, earthquake, tornado, or other acts of nature. This warranty does not apply to products installed in vacation homes which do not maintain year-round environmental controls or to products in areas with exposure to extreme humidity or extreme temperature fluctuations. Also, this warranty does not apply to the mellowing and aging of wood products, variations in wood grain or color, fading or visible cracking around joints (particularly finish cracks related to paint finishes), and countertop staining, fading, discoloration or seam separation.

If components are replaced, neither Schuon Kitchen and Baths, Inc., the cabinet manufacturer or the countertop supplier can guarantee that the finish of these replacement parts will exactly match the finish and appearance to the original components. This is due to changes that occur during the woods' or stone's natural aging process or the inability to procure additional countertop material from the same lot or bundle.

This is the exclusive warranty of Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc., and is expressly in lieu of all other warranties and conditions, expressed or implied, including any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. We do not authorize any other person or company to assume on or behalf, any other liability in connection with this warranty. Schuon Kitchens and Baths, Inc. warranty applies to orders shipped on or after June 30, 2010.

Any unresolved controversy or claim arising from or under the Limited Lifetime Warranty shall be settled by arbitration and judgement upon the award rendered may be entered in any State of Georgia Court of competent jurisdiction. The arbitration shall be held under the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
